Quicksand by Iris Johansen

This is a story involving one of my favourite characters, a forensic sculptor, named Eve Duncan. Years ago her daughter Bonnie vanished without a trace and since that day Eve's life has become an obsession to find Bonnie's remains and put the pain of her death to rest. However, one man wants nothing more than to prevent that from happening. He is every woman's waking nightmare: a brilliant, ruthless killer whose hunting ground stretches from coast to coast. A book you keep reading far into the night.

Phantom Prey by John Sandford

Lucas Davenport returns and has had disturbing cases before – but never one quite like this. When a daughter is missing and the police can't find the girl alive or dead, Lucas is asked to get involved. Clues don't seem to add up and Lucas keeps getting the sneaking suspicion that something else is going on here....something very, very bad indeed.

Cold Plague by Daniel Kalla

Pristine water – hidden for millions of years, untouched by pollution, and possessing natural healing powers – is found miles under Antarctic ice. Dr. Noah Haldane, after facing a spate of disappearances and unexplained deaths, uncovers a conspiracy that stretches from St.Petersburg, Russian to Beverly Hills, and from the North to the South Pole.

Eyes Of The World by Rob Palmer

As the first female president of the United States, Carolyn Connor is under constant intense scrutiny. A secret she is trying to hide could be blown sky high when a woman close to her is murdered. A childhood friend, Mike Stanbridge is the main suspect. With political assassins trying to kill him and the FBI trying to arrest him, Mike will need to move fast if he wants to stay alive and find the truth behind the lies. A good read.

Sundays At Tiffany's by James Patterson

What if your imaginary friend from childhood was your one true love?

This is not the usual mystery, blood and guts from James Patterson but a magical story of a love that's too perfect to be real. I thoroughly enjoyed this love story although it isn't the genre I normally read. It was a fast read but a really good read.
