Fire Chief John Reid gave the Fire Chief's Report. There have still been some issues with neighbor municipalities not answering their fire calls. Fire Dept. radios were discussed, and the fact that the municipality will need to upgrade their radio system in the upcoming years. Staff are directed to start researching on possible options, including leasing vs. purchasing new equipment.
