That we recommend to Council that the municipality commit to finishing Walnut Lane in the Hodgins Subdivision in the 2018 budget.......carried.

The petition signed by 14 residents of the Blue Road requesting "chip and tar" be applied to the surface of the roadway to alleviate safety concerns was discussed by Committee and it was determined that this will be considered in the 2018 budget.

That we direct staff to write to the Ministry of Transportation regarding the Municipality's displeasure with the paving that was done on Highway 542 west of Mindemoya this August, in which none of the aprons of the intersecting municipal roads were paved as committed to in previous years, creating safety and maintenance concerns for the municipality and further that there appears to have not been any patching of roadway defects before the paving was carried out, creating a very unsatisfactory road surface.......carried.
