BY-LAW NUMBER 99-

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW #75-06 AND 94-09 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNARVON WHICH AUTHORIZES THE ROAD SUPERINTENDENT TO ERECT STOP SIGNS IN SPECIFIED AREAS OF THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF CARNARVON.

WHEREAS 3-way "stop" signs have been erected at the intersection of Will-o'-the-Wisp Way and Ketchankookem Trail; and

AND WHEREAS the "stop" signs on Ketchankookem Trail, eastbound and westbound were installed for the safety of children at the swimming area and vehicular traffic at the boat launching ramp, and

AND WHEREAS Council deems that these two signs are not necessary during the fall and winter season and create more of a problem for traffic during these seasons;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin amends item #1 as follows:

 That 3-way "Stop" signs be erected at the intersection of Will-o'-the-Wisp Way and Ketchankookem Trail during the period of May 1st and October 30th of each year; and

That the two 'stop' signs travelling eastward and westward on Ketchankookem Trail be either covered or removed during the period of November 1st to April 30th of each year.
