CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW No. 99-10

BEING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CENTRAL MANITOULIN PROCEDURAL BY-LAW 98-03.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Central Manitoulin has passed By-law 98-03 setting the rules and regulations to be followed for the dispatch of business and to maintain order in the proceedings of Council and in the committees thereof, and;

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to clarify the procedures to be followed by committees of Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin enacts that By-law 98-03 be amended to include the following:

- 1) That Committee chairs, unless they vacate the chair, do not normally move or second motions, nor vote upon them except to break a tie, and;
- 2) That a quorum is two members (including the chair). If only two members are present, the chair may wish to move or second motions, and any recommendations to Council will note that there was a minimum quorum at the committee meeting, and;
- 3) That committees will otherwise follow the rules of procedure of the Township's procedural by-law, as applicable
