Every person who contravenes any provision of any of the bylaws to which this amendment pertains shall upon conviction be liable to the maximum fines as allowed by the Municipal Act or Provincial Offences Act as applicable.

- 2. All other performance standards and provisions of the preceding bylaws as listed which are not specifically varied hereby continue to apply.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final reading subject to the expiration of the 20 day appeal period, provided in Section 34(18) of the Planning Act and subject to approval of the Ontario Municipal Board where objections to this by-law are filed with the Municipal Clerk.
