There was no declaration of pecuniary interest.

The committee discussed the progress of the Gagnon Renewables Project. Due to the current situation in Brazil (manufacturing location of the system to be used), Gagnon is unable to move forward with the project at this time.

That we recommend to Council to continue having landfill hours on Thursday afternoon at Providence Bay Land fill for a one-year trial period ...carried.

The committee discussed glass and composting. The issue of glass pulverizing is to be brought up at the next MMA meeting.

That staff obtain costing information on a program of home composting, with an education component and sourcing for worms...carried.

That we recommend to Council that the proposed 2021 Library Budget be accepted and be forwarded to the Committee of the Whole meeting in January...**Motion Withdrawn**

Staff is directed to obtain budgets from other libraries for comparison. This issue is to be discussed at the next WWE meeting.
