Ms. Tann has just sent us the existing drawing for the Old School building today, copies were made available at the meeting. They have been provided free of charge. She will be invited to our next meeting to explore possible changes to the interior design.

There was some discussion on making the building accessible by chair lift or elevator. Other possible funding sources were briefly discussed with Ontario Trillium Foundation once again being brought forward. Jan McQuay has set up a meeting with Mary Nelder for June 20 at 10:00 a.m. for advice on possible funding sources. Any committee member available is welcome and location is to be determined. Joanne Smith will contact Carolyn Lane-Rock for advice also.

The committee is concerned about the unknown condition of the roof. They would like to explore the existing condition before making any recommendation to Council for an investment to maintain the structure of the building. Hal has agreed to find equipment without cost and contractors willing to provide a report on the existing condition and an estimate for any repairs or replacement. This update on the roof will help the committee to show Council and taxpayers

that they are making efforts to reduce the burden for investing into the building. The Municipal Office will be made aware of this endeavour. If any fundraising efforts are undertaken it should also engage the community so they feel a part of the project.

The committee will consider making a request to Council for more time to complete their mandate in the near future and it should not to be taken as an ask for more money.
