- That Eastlink would be responsible for removing and/or moving and reconstruction (put back)
 any fiber conduit and fiber optics in the case any future major Municipal construction work
 including but not limited to road maintenance/upgrades, potential sewer and water installations
 without cost to the Municipality,
- That prior to the project the Roads Superintendent and KG Reid will stake the culverts and locations for the fiber optics.
- That a more detailed reinstatement clause will be added regarding replacing to original where compaction and other factors are clearly listed beyond point 3. of by-law 2010-18 Appendix A and A-1,

- That any property owners' water lines be considered of equal importance to any other portion
 of project and locating water services, the depth and placement of fiber cable and care and
 replacement of these water lines if damaged, pay all expenses incurred while making an
 installation, to restore said property to its original condition or better upon completion of
 installation,
