BY-LAW NUMBER 2021-13

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT COMMUNITY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATORS

WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 380/04 made pursuant to the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, requires every municipality to designate an employee of the municipality or a member of the council as its Emergency Management Program Coordinator who shall co-ordinate the development and implementation of the municipality's emergency management program with the municipality and shall co-ordinate the municipality's emergency management program in so far as possible with the emergency management programs of other municipalities, of Ministries of the Ontario Government and of organizations outside government that are involved in emergency management;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin wishes to appoint a new Emergency Management Program Coordinator, otherwise know as, and hereinafter referred to as CEMC.

Now THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

- 1. That Hayley Nicklasson is hereby appointed as the primary CEMC responsible for all emergency management programs, including maintenance of the emergency response plan, training, public education and such other duties and responsibilities as out lined in the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*.
- 2. That Ruth Frawley, CAO/Clerk is hereby appointed as the alternate CEMC to act in place of the primary CEMC in her absence.
- 3. That Denise Deforge, Deputy Clerk is hereby appointed as the second alternate CEMC to act in place of the primary CEMC in the absence of the first alternate.
