ROAD COMMITTEE MINUTES

OCTOBER 6, 2020

Attending: Chairperson Councillor D. Stephens, Mayor R. Stephens, Councillor Johnston, Scott, Shaffer and Tribinevicius, along with the CAO/Clerk and Road Superintendent. Councillor Diebolt sent her regrets.

MOTION: R. Stephens and Johnston

That the agenda be approved as presented.....carried.

There were no declarations of pecuniary interest.

MOTION: Tribinevicius and Shaffer

That the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Road Committee held on September 1, 2020 be approved.....carried.

The Clerk was asked to find out more information about the possibility of the Municipality ticketing vehicles on its own roadways.

MOTION: Shaffer and R. Stephens

That we recommend to Council that the Municipality accept the proposed repairs of the 2019 surface treatment by MSO as outlined in Chris Maguire’s email of October 5, 2020 and that the work will be done in the Spring of 2021.....carried.

The Clerk was asked to arrange a ZOOM meeting between Council with the Ministry of Transportation and the Ontario Provincial Police to discuss the reduction of speed on Highway 551 coming from the north into Mindemoya and the criteria for a cross walk between Sparrow’s Nest apartments and the new sidewalk along Highway 551.

The Road Superintendent presented a cost estimate to bring Hill Crest Road up to Municipal Standards. An email from Trevor Aljoe was also presented in which he was not willing to cost share on the project. In light of this response the Clerk was directed to write Mr. Aljoe and let him know that the matter is now closed.

A letter from the United Manitoulin Island Transportation group was discussed requesting that the Municipality apply for Gas Tax transit funding on the groups behalf and also consider helping to fund the initiative.

That the letter of request for funding from United Manitoulin Island Transit be forwarded to the next Manitoulin Municipal Association meeting for discussion.....carried.

MOTION: Johnston and Shaffer

That we recommend to Council that the year to date financial report ending September 30, 2020 for the Roads Committee be approved.....carried.

MOTION: Johnston and R. Stephens

That we accept the Road Superintendents monthly report as presented.....carried.
