BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN TO AUTHORIZE THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT IN A SPECIFIC AREA IN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS it is authorized under the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>, Chapter H.8, part IX, Section 128(2); and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin deems it advisable to reduce the speed limit on the following road from an unposted speed limit to a posted 50 km/hr;

❖ TRACY ROAD EAST OF THE INTERSECTION WITH MONUMENT ROAD AND ALL OF DEERFOOT TRAIL - the signs to be placed near the intersection of TRACY ROAD EAST AND MONUMENT ROAD and the intersection of TRACY ROAD EAST AND DEERFOOT TRAIL.

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the 50 km/hr. speed signs be erected at the place listed above;
- 2. And that this by-law becomes effective on the date of its passing.
