Municipality of Central Manitoulin Safety, Security and Health Committee Minutes November 21st, 2017

That the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Safety, Security and Health Committee held on October 17th, 2017 be approved as circulated...carried.

That we recommend to Council to adopt By-law 2017-18, and further that the Emergency Management Program Committee meet at least twice a year...carried.

Staff gave a verbal report to committee regarding changes to the *Ambulance Act*. The proposed amendments are part of *Bill 160, Strengthening Quality and Accountability for Patients Act, 2017,* omnibus legislation which addresses several changes in the healthcare system.

The committee discussed correspondence from Derek Graham, Chair of the Manitoulin Physician Recruitment Sub-Committee. The letter was an update to community partners, as well as a request for continued funding.

That we recommend to Council to earmark and flow the same contribution amount that was provided last year, to the Manitoulin Physician Recruitment Sub-Committee...carried.

The Joint Health & Safety committee minutes of November 8th, 2017 were discussed, and will be sent back to the committee for further discussion.

That we recommend to Council to declare the week of February 1st to February 8th, 2018, as Eating Disorder Awareness Week...carried.

That we accept the minutes of the Manitoulin Centennial Manor of June 15th, 2017 and July 20th, 2017...carried.

Staff gave a verbal report on Bill 65, Safer School Zones Act, 2017, to the committee for information.

The committee reviewed correspondence from Petra Wall. Ms. Wall is requesting Council to ban the use of herbicide in the municipality of Central Manitoulin. Staff is to invite representatives from Hydro One, Manitoulin Streams, and Petra Wall to a Safety, Security, and Health committee meeting, either in January or February of 2018.

That we accept the Fire Chief's report for information...carried.

That we accept the year to date financial report ending on October 31st, 2017...carried.
