

The Municipality of Central Manitoulin
By-law Number 2014-10

Being a by-law to provide for and authorize the use of Vote by Mail as an alternative voting method and tabulation hardware for the purpose of counting votes

Whereas Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act 1996, c32*, as amended provides that a Municipal Council may pass a By-law authorizing the use of vote counting equipment and use of an alternative voting method; and

Whereas Section 42 (5) of the *Municipal Elections Act 1996, c32*, as amended provides that a Municipal Council may use alternative voting in lieu of advanced votes and voting proxies; and

Whereas Council deems it appropriate and in the public interest of the electors to conduct the 2014 Municipal Election using a vote by mail method and vote counting equipment.

Now Therefore the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the use of voting by mail as an alternative voting method is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held in 2014.
2. That the use of vote counting equipment is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held in 2014.
3. That the provisions in the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, relating to proxy voting and advance voting will not apply in the 2014 Municipal Election.
4. That this by-law comes into full force and effect on the date of its passing.
