THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

By-law Number 2009-18

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH NO PARKING AREAS ON YONGE ST. IN MINDEMOYA

WHEREAS, the municipality finds it advisable to erect no parking signs at specific locations;

AND WHEREAS under section 28(2) (b) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 2001, which states that, except as otherwise provided in this Act or under section 8 of the *Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act*, a local municipality has jurisdiction over all road allowances, highways, streets and lanes within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and appropriate to ensure the safety of residents of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin;

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

- 1. That NO PARKING signs be installed on the East side of Yonge St. between the Duke St. Intersection and Hwy. 542.
- 2. That there shall be no parking of vehicles on the East side of Yonge St. between the intersection of Duke and Yonge Street and the intersection of Yonge St. and Hwy. 542 in the village of Mindemoya.
- 3. That NO PARKING signs be installed on the West side of Yonge St. between Hwy. 542 and the Foodland Entrance.
- 4. That there shall be no parking of vehicles on the West side of Yonge St. between the intersection of Yonge St. and Hwy. 542 and the Foodland Entrance.
- 5. The owner of any vehicle found to be in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of \$ 50.00 dollars, exclusive of costs, which shall be recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O.1990 as amended.
- 6. That this By-Law shall come into force and take affect on the date of passing by the Municipal Council.
