## BY-LAW 2002-27

Being a by-law to continue the tax benefit to Councillors

WHEREAS subsection 255 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, as amended, provides that one-third of the remuneration paid to elected members of Councils and their local boards shall be considered as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of council or local board; and

WHEREAS subsection 255 (2) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. M. 45, as amended, provides that the provisions of subsection 255(1) shall only continue to apply to members f council or its local boards after January 1, 2003 if the municipality passes a resolution before January 1, 2003 stating its intention that the provisions of subsection 255(1) shall continue to apply to elected members of council and its local boards; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Central Manitoulin hereby deems it desirable to continue the provisions of subsection 255(1) of the Municipal Act beyond January 1, 2003.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
