A regular meeting of the Water, Waste & Education Committee was held on February 02, 2023 by video conference with the following in attendance:

Further discussion of both the Mindemoya and Providence Bay Waste Disposal Site Annual Groundwater Monitoring Reports is deferred to the next WWE Committee meeting.
