

TOWNSHIP OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW 2004-22

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE BY-LAW 2000-002 "A" AN ENTRANCE PERMIT SYSTEM FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN.

WHEREAS THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN FINDS IT ADVISABLE TO HAVE AN ENTRANCE PERMIT SYSTEM, AND;

WHEREAS UNDER Chapter M.45, Section 262, Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, the council of every municipality has jurisdiction over all highways and bridges within the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

THAT Schedule "A" be amended to read:

12 (b) New corrugated galvanized metal pipe or ribbed plastic pipe shall be used.

(c) The minimum culvert length shall be twenty-five feet (25 feet) depending on the depth and other conditions and as required by the road supt. and the minimum diameter shall be 15 inches. Minimum thickness shall be 16 gauge(1.6mm).
