The Road Superintendent explained the 2020 Surface Treatment contract being issued through the Manitoulin-Northshore Road Superintendents Association. The consensus of Council was to agree with the tender going to Beamish Construction for the 2020 surface treatment contract.

The Road Superintendent was asked to place the vehicle counter on the roadway to assess the amount of traffic, and to give Council a better understanding of the numbers of vehicles using the Rockville Road.
