# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP <br> OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN <br> BY-LAW NUMBER 99-04 

## BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH LOAD RESTRICTIONS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, Section 122 authorizes Council to pass by-laws to place load restrictions on Municipal Roads;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin deems it necessary to prohibit the travelling of full load vehicles on Township roads during certain times of the year;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

1. THAT all by-laws established by the former Township of Carnarvon or the Township of Sandfield to establish Half Loading Restrictions on Township Roads are hereby rescinded.
2. THAT full load vehicles be prohibited from travelling on Township roads during certain times of the year as set out from time to time by the Road Superintendent and/or in conjunction with the same regulations set out under the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8.
3. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offense under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. In the event that any provision of the By-law shall be deemed void or invalid by court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions or parts shall be and remain in full force and effect.
5. This by-law shall come into effect upon the third and final reading.
