COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY-JANUARY 25, 2021

Attending: Mayor R. Stephens, Councillors Diebolt, Johnston, Scott, Shaffer, D. Stephens and Tribinevicius, along with the CAO/Clerk, Treasurer, Road Superintendent, Maintenance Supervisor, Fire Chief, and one member of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

MOTION: D. Stephens and Diebolt

That the agenda be approved with the addition of three by-laws, 2021-01 Borrowing By-law, 2021-02 Interim Tax Levy, and 2021-03 Tax Capping By-law.....carried.

There were no declarations of pecuniary interest.

MOTION: D. Stephens and Diebolt

That we recommend to Council that By-law 2021-01, being a By-law to authorize the borrowing of money to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin, be given its three readings and be duly passed......carried.

MOTION: Johnston and Shaffer

That we recommend to Council that By-law 2021-02, being a By-law to impose an interim tax levy for the current year, be given its three readings and be duly passed......carried.

MOTION: D. Stephens and Shaffer

That we recommend to Council that By-law 2021-03, being a By-law to adopt optional tools for the purposes of administering taxation limits for Commercial, Industrial and Multi-Residential property classes for the year 2021, be given its three readings and be duly passed......carried.

The Mayor gave an overview of taxation and assessment for the past several years and the way they work together to supply revenue for the Municipality to carry out its annual operations.

The Committee reviewed and adjusted the 2021 Operating budget.

The Committee next reviewed the 2021 Capital Budget, making some adjustments to the Road Department Capital Budget. The Committee began its review of the Property Committee's Capital Budget.

The Capital Budget review was not completed, and it was decided to continue on Wednesday, January 27th, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.
