MOTION: Johnston and Scott

- c. Sidewalk Construction-Five emails between the Municipality and Tulloch Engineering regarding the state of the sidewalk were reviewed.,

That we recommend to Council that the municipality permit Joyce and Jack Varieur, if necessary, to have the overhanging trees removed from the municipal lot (Plan M-158 31R-342, Part 2, Sandfield Township), by a qualified arborist, provided that municipal staff are consulted on which trees will be removed..........carried.

That we recommend to Council that the municipality have the road department erect a bus stop sign near 1751 Monument Road......carried.
