The Road Superintendent stated that the ruts at the side of the road have been filled in and leveled by staff. The Road Superintendent was asked to come up with possible options for committee's consideration at the next meeting for parking in this area.

A letter from Guy Nielen was received by the committee regarding his suggestion that the municipality consider one-way traffic for the Hodgins Subdivision roads. The Road Superintendent was asked to further explore this idea, coming back to the Road Committee with a recommendation.
