The committee discussed whether there might be any public perception issues with having two Councillors on the committee who would also have a vote on any recommendations put forward by the committee once those recommendations get to the Property Committee and Council level.

The committee discussed the importance of having a publicity component to the Climate Action Plan, and agreed to put discussion of the potential for declaring a Climate Change Emergency on the next meeting's agenda. There was some discussion of having a website or facebook presence. There was also some discussion of whether working groups would allow committee members to keep making progress on specific tasks between meetings.
