

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN**

BY-LAW 2002-18

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 98-17 A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF
ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the Council of a Municipality may by By-Law establish and regulate a Fire Department;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin wishes to amend By-law 98-17 being a By-law establishing a volunteer fire department;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

1. That Section 3.a) be amended to read;

In addition to the Chief of the Department the Department personnel shall consist of three District Chiefs who shall report to the Chief. Reporting to each of the three District Chiefs shall be three Ward Lieutenants. One of the District Chiefs shall be appointed as First Deputy Chief another shall be appointed as the Second Deputy Chief. The Chief and both Deputies shall be appointed from different wards. Council shall appoint officers and members, as from time to time may be deemed necessary, by recommendation of the Chief.

2. That Section 7. be amended to read;

The District Chiefs shall be responsible to the Chief, and the duties of the District Chiefs shall include:

- (a) to maintain all Fire Departments records within their ward.
- (b) to arrange for the provision of medical services within their ward; and
- (c) to prepare the annual report of the Department within their ward; and
- (d) to carry out the general administrative duties of the Department within their ward.

3. That Section 26 be added to read;

Any person or corporation who causes or permits to cause more than one false alarm is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine for the second offence of \$ 300.00 and for the third and any subsequent offences of \$ 500.00 recoverable under in the Provincial Offences Act. After the first false alarm, a notice, with a copy of by-law 2002-18 attached, shall be sent to the person or corporation who caused or permitted to cause a false alarm.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 23rd DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2002.
