

MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2008-24

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ROAD DEPARTMENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN TO ERECT STOP SIGNS IN SPECIFIC AREAS OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS Section 11 (3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, CHAPTER 25 and amendments thereto empower municipalities to pass by-laws, subject to the rules set out in subsection (4), respecting matters concerning Highways, including parking and traffic on highways.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin deems it advisable to erect a traffic control (STOP) sign at the following location:

North-east end of Earl's Road at the intersection of White Church Road

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Stop sign be erected at the intersection listed above;
2. And that this by-law becomes effective on the date of its passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 28th DAY OF AUGUST, 2008.
