

MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2009-11

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO REPRESENTED BY THE DEPUTY PREMIER AND MINISTER OF ENERGY AND INFRASTRUCTURE, AND THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD & RURAL AFFAIRS.

WHEREAS Section 10 (2) 6 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, CHAPTER 25 and amendments thereto empower municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters concerning the health, safety and well-being of persons and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin deems it expedient and in the public interest to enter into a funding contract with HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO REPRESENTED BY THE DEPUTY PREMIER AND MINISTER OF ENERGY AND INFRASTRUCTURE, AND THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD & RURAL AFFAIRS for the Build Canada Fund Communities Component (BCF-CC);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN ENACTS AS FOLLOW:

That the Agreement between the Municipality of Central Manitoulin and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO REPRESENTED BY THE DEPUTY PREMIER AND MINISTER OF ENERGY AND INFRASTRUCTURE, AND THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD & RURAL AFFAIRS for the Build Canada Fund Communities Component (BCF-CC);

1. attached hereto as Schedule "A-1" is hereby approved.
2. That the Deputy Reeve and CAO-Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and seal the said Agreement.
3. That the Agreement, attached as Schedule "A-1", hereto forms part of this by-law.
4. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on April 10, 2009.
