

MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2010-21

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN'S RESTRICTED AREA ZONING BY-LAW NUMBER 2002-07 (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS the Planning Act, R.S.O., Section 34, provides for the amendment of By-laws.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin has received a request to amended Restricted Area Zoning By-law 2002-07 (as amended) as it applies to property described as Part Lot 20 Concession 5, Plan 31R-3615 Part 2 in the Township of Carnarvon, Municipality of Central Manitoulin, District of Manitoulin.

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Central Manitoulin has ensured that adequate information has been made available to the public and has held at least one (1) public meeting after due notice for the purpose of informing the public of this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin enacts as follows:

1. That Central Manitoulin Restricted Area Zoning By-law 2002-07 (as amended) is hereby further amended by adding section 8.51 to site specifically allow for "Commercial Storage Units" to be built and operated at the aforementioned location.
2. Section 5, Definitions, of Restricted Area Zoning By-law 2002-07 is hereby amended to add the following definition:

"COMMERCIAL STORAGE UNIT" shall hereby be defined as a building that is primarily used to provide, controlled access, individual storage spaces to the public, and that is open for use to the public, only for those purposes.

3. All other permitted uses, performance standards and provisions of the Rural zone as described in Restricted Area Zoning by-law Number 2002-07 as amended which are not specifically varied hereby continue to apply.
4. That Schedule "A" of Central Manitoulin By-law 2002-07 as amended shall form part of this by-law.
5. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final reading subject to the expiration of the 20 day appeal period, provided in Section 34(18) of the Planning Act and subject to approval of the Ontario Municipal Board where objections to this by-law are filed with the Municipal Clerk.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 10th DAY OF JUNE, 2010.
