

MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2020-09

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ROAD DEPARTMENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN TO ERECT A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGN A IN SPECIFIC AREA OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS Section 11 (3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, CHAPTER 25 and amendments thereto empower municipalities to pass by-laws, subject to the rules set out in subsection (4), respecting matters concerning Highways, including parking and traffic on highways.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin deems it advisable to erect traffic control (STOP) signs at the following locations:

(1) Southeast corner at the intersection of the road allowance between Lots 5 and 6 on Concession 15, Campbell Township (White's Lane) and Sand Road

and

(2) Southeast corner at the intersection Government Road and the road allowance between Lots 10 and 11 on Concession 13, Carnarvon Township.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Stop signs be erected at the intersections listed above;
2. And that this by-law becomes effective on the date of its passing.
