

MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN

BY-LAW No. 2020-10

BEING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CENTRAL MANITOULIN
PROCEDURAL BY-LAW .

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin has passed By-law 2017-08 setting the rules and regulations to be followed for the dispatch of business and to maintain order in the proceedings of Council and in the committees thereof, and;

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to allow for electronic meetings for Council meetings and committees and;

WHEREAS the Provincial Government has passed Bill 187, the Municipal Emergency Act, 2020; to amend the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 238 by allow for electronic meetings;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Central Manitoulin enacts that By-law 2017-08 be amended to include the following:

- 1) during any period where an emergency has been declared to exist in all or part of the municipality under section 4 or 7.0.1 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act and;
- 2) despite subsection (3.1) of the Municipal Act, a member of a council, of a local board or of a committee of either of them who is participating electronically in a meeting may be counted in determining whether or not a quorum of members is present at any point in time; and
- 3) despite subsection (3.2) of the Municipal Act, a member of a council, of a local board or of a committee of either of them can participate electronically in a meeting that is closed to the public.
