

**MUNICIPALITY OF CENTRAL MANITOULIN
WATER, WASTE & EDUCATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES –March 5, 2020**

A regular meeting of the Water, Waste & Education Committee was held on March 5, 2020 in the Council Chambers with the following in attendance:

That staff prepare a home composting strategy for the Municipality for presentation to the committee...carried.

Staff is to research the cost of back yard composters for sale/distribution to the public as part of the home composting strategy.

Staff is directed to research the costs of a glass grinder for the Municipality. Staff is also to set up a public meeting to discuss issues of glass recycling and home composting.

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The report regarding the transition of Blue Box to Full Producer Responsibility was discussed by the Committee
